Alumni Fund Application Information:

The Newfoundland and Labrador Basketball Association (NLBA) is a nonprofit sport governing body for basketball in Newfoundland and Labrador. The Alumni Fund is a program created by the Executive Board and Alumni Committee to assist with athletes facing social and economic barriers. It will allow access to a small amount of funding to assist with the financial burden of competing on a provincial team commencing in 2018.

Privacy/Confidentiality: The NLBA respects your privacy and the laws surrounding such. We never trade, sell or loan your information to any organization. Information provided in this application is being collected for the sole purpose of administrating the Alumni Fund. This information will only be disclosed to the people directly involved in the process, who will need the information to carry out the responsibilities connected to the selection of athletes for these grants.

Alumni Fund Guidelines

- Open to NLBA athletes selected to the provincial teams travelling to National championships only.
- Athletes must apply for and be eligible to receive or to have received, in the current calendar year; funding under KidSport and/or the REAL program. This does not mean that you will automatically receive support. It simply means you are eligible to apply.
- Applications can only be submitted once per year with a deadline of June 10th. All applications will be processed prior to the AGM in late June.
- Athletes will have to provide a manuscript of school marks.

Alumni Funds Criteria

- Must apply and be eligible for KidSport Funding. Applicants must also apply to any other local organizations such as the REAL program or Mt. Pearl Sport Alliance.
- Limited to teams travelling to National Midget and Juvenile Championships.
- Coaches and Managers need to endorse applications.
- The number of grants per season as well as the amount will be determined by the Alumni Committee in conjunction with the Executive Board.
- Applications must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian. In cases where parents have gone through a divorce or separation, both parents must sign the application if they share custody.
- The skill level of an athlete will not play any impact in determining who is awarded funding.
- Alternates are permitted to apply as long as they secure a place on the team and attend nationals.
- Preference may be given to athletes:
 - Outside Training Region
 - Single Parents
 - More than one child in the program
- Athletes who depart or are dismissed from a program will forfeit their grant.
