Registration Fees:

Grade 4 = \$104.00

Grades 5 and 6 = \$312.00

Grades, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 = \$364.00

- ✓ The East and West Coast will be divided at Gander, with Gander included in the West Coast Category.
- ✓ Exceptions may be permitted upon submission of written requests sent to the office for executive approval.
- ✓ All tournaments will be grade based. Teams and athletes are able to play in a higher grade tournament.
- ✓ Individuals and teams cannot play in a lower grade tournament.
- ✓ The NLBA office and the minor committee will decide which teams go to the "A", "B" or "C" events.
- ✓ There will be sanctions and / or fines for teams that withdraw from an event after it starts.
- ✓ By entering any of these events, coaches agree to abide by the rules of the NLBA

Important Information and Notes: *(Please Read)*

REGISTRATION FEE:

\$104.00 for Grade 4 – 3 on3 boys' and girls' tournaments,
\$312.00 for Grade 5 and Grade 6 boys' and girls' tournaments,
ALL other tournaments \$364.00 payable to NLBA (must accompany form).

NEW DEADLINES:

January 10, 2018 for the Grades 4, 5, 6 and 7 – Applications must be in provincial office.
January 31, 2018 for the Grades 8, 9, 10 and 11 – Applications must be in provincial office.
Applications will not be accepted unless accompanied by fees.

The NLBA office and the minor committee will determine which teams go to the “A”, “B” or “C” events.

- Back of applications must be complete with mailing addresses, postal codes, birth dates, phone numbers, and emails at least 14 days prior to the tournament!
- There is no need to place a formal protest for ineligible players. The game is automatically defaulted. Opposing team wins by 20-0 score.

Please note at the NLBA's AGM in June 2017 following the motions were made and approved:

Commissionaires: Committee agreed to leave at grade 5-6 for now as these parents and coaches are entering grade 7 with the knowledge learned from the last 2 years.

3 x 3 Grade 4: Committee agreed to provide a video and place it on the web to educate coaches. This may increase team's entering and also applying to host when they are able to see the game on a video. NLBA to tape some of the House of Hoops for the web.

Medal shortage at presentations: Committee agreed to provide extra medals to the grades 5-6 championships for the 2018 season.

Earrings and stud issues: The FIBA rule to be placed into the booklet so coaches have easy access to the rule. Coaches are still responsible for educating their coaches on this rule.

- Apparently there is still an issue where some officials show leniency and then when they attend another event the other officials enforce.

4 vs 5 Player Foul Rule Pilot: Committee agreed to run the pilot again this year and evaluate again at the end of next year.

- 4 foul rule will be in effect for grades 5-7 for the school championships again in 2018.
