U11 Notes

- All games will be played under the usual Minor Provincial School Championships
- This age group will be using "Fair Play Rules" as outlined in Booklet.

U13 Notes

- These are not Fair Play games. You do not have to have 10 players to compete.
- No Zone defences permitted in the back court as per minor rules.
- 4-8 minute periods with 10 second half court cross and 30 second shot clock.
- Teams are permitted to register and play a maximum of 15 players per game.

All rosters must be in 14 days prior to the event. No changes will be permitted 48 hours prior to the start of the event.

Due to the location and number of teams travelling to provincial championships there are always a number of requests taken into consideration when developing a schedule. Changes in a schedule will have a snowball effect on all teams involved in the tournament once it is forwarded to the teams. The NLBA WILL NOT permit changes to a schedule unless approved by the minor committee, once it leaves the provincial office. The NLBA would like to take this opportunity to wish all teams entered the best of luck in their respective tournament.
